How the awards are judged: An independent judge will review the applications, shortlist three apprentices and choose the winning apprentice.

Award Criteria

The judge is looking for:

- Apprentices who can demonstrate their achievements, contribution and the impact they have made within the organisation they work.
- Apprentices who are committed to their continuing professional development.
- Apprentices who embrace the use of new technology, materials and ways of working in order to maximise efficiency and reduce costs.

Awards: The three shortlisted apprentices will be invited as guests of ICOM to attend the ICOM Annual Luncheon, to be held at St Ermins Hotel, London on 6th June 2024, where the ICOM Apprentice of the Year Award will be presented.

The winning apprentice will receive a trophy, a certificate and a gift voucher. The ICOM member with the winning apprentice will get a £250 reduction in their 2025 subscription fee, a feature in the ICOM weekly news, a news article on the ICOM website and social media event coverage.

How to apply: There is no fee to apply for the ICOM Apprentice of the Year Award. ICOM members may nominate apprentices who have reached the height of excellence in their chosen apprenticeship. Nominees must be currently on an apprenticeship programme or have finished their apprenticeship within the 12 months previous to 3rd May 2024. The apprentices must be nominated by an ICOM member company and should be working within the ICOM member company.
